



# FELLOWSHIP/RESIDENCY IN FORENSIC ODONTOLOGY

The Forensic odontology department of the LSJML is proud to present a new specialized training offering : an 18-month advanced training program designed for dentists seeking to develop comprehensive expertise in forensic odontology.

Hybrid training in both French and English combining structured virtual instruction and intensive laboratory-based training.

## TRAINING OBJECTIVES

This training aims to enable dentists to develop skills in forensic odontology, particularly in the following areas :

- Forensic dental identification
- Dental age assessment
- Bitemark analysis and interpretation
- Participation in disaster victim identification (DVI) operations
- Interdisciplinary collaboration with forensic pathologists and forensic anthropologists
- Expert testimony in legal proceedings

## COHORT

- Maximum of 6 participants
- Selection based on application file review and interview
- First cohort begins : October 2026
- Attendance required at the LSJML : March & June 2027, April 2028
- Application deadline : June 30, 2026

## PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Theoretical Instruction : virtual sessions held every two weeks, directed readings, assignments, and case studies.

Practical Training : three intensive in-person weeks at the LSJML.
